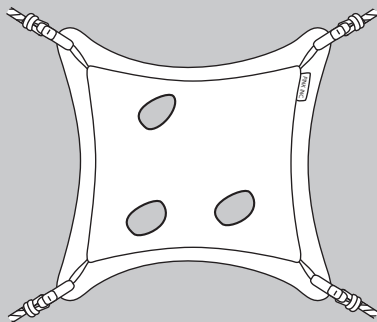
1. Before handling the fabric, wash hands and lay out the drop cloth in work area. Next, lay out the fabric and locate the 4 loops.



2. The Aurora has four equal sides. It also has a "true" front and back. The back has visible seams and a tag.

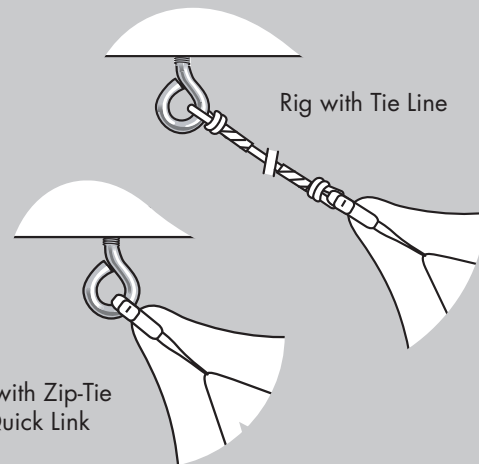


3. To rig with zip-ties or quick links: Determine rigging points and move onto step 4.



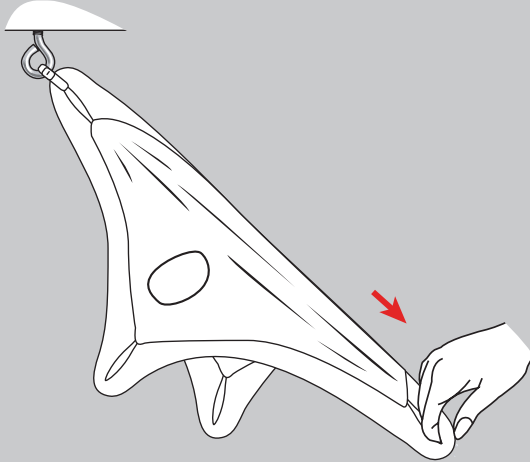
To rig with tie line: Determine rigging points and an approximate length for the line. Attach the lines to the loops using zip-ties.

4. Secure the first loop to one of the rigging points using the chosen rigging method.

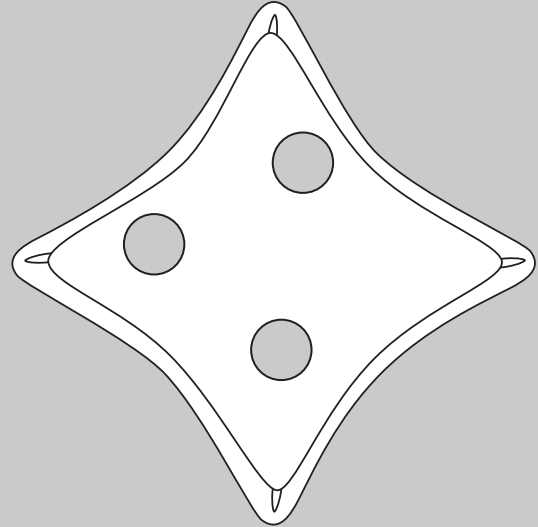

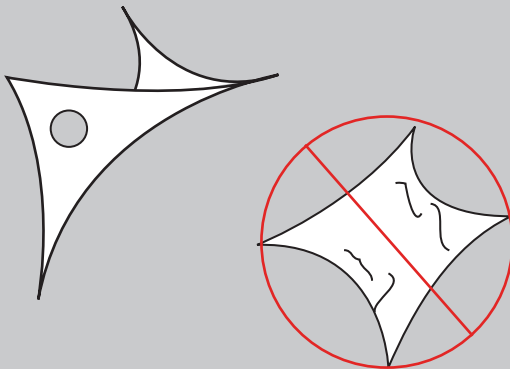
5. Locate the loop opposite of the secured point and stretch away from it. Attach this before moving on to the other points. This establishes the correct tension.



6. Attach the remaining points. Tidy up any excess tie line if it was used.



7. Other ideas for rigging:
It is possible to make 3D shapes by pulling points in opposite direction. Be sure opposite points are pulled along the same plane.



Trouble Shooting:

- If wrinkles are present:
 - * Stretch further to increase tension;
 - * Be sure opposite points are stretched along the same plane.
