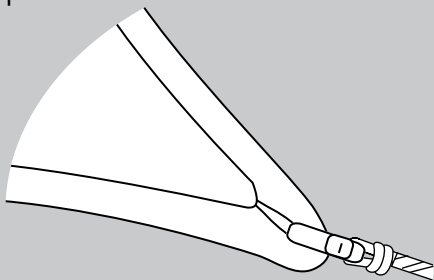
1. Before handling the fabric, wash hands and lay out the drop cloth in work area. Be sure to have an ample work area - when fully stretched, the Gruyere reaches 30' x 30' between opposite points.



2. The Gruyere has a "true" front and back. The back has visible seams and a tag. Also please note the loose ends, which will be used for rigging.

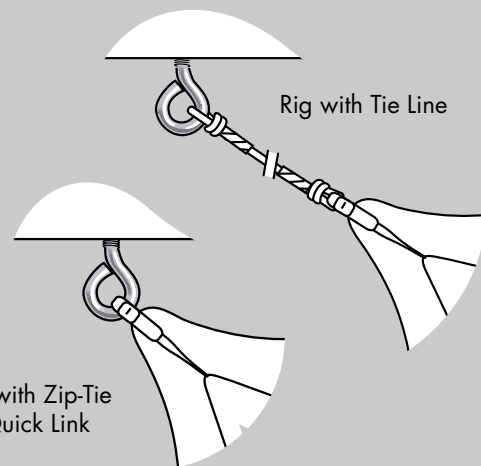


3. To rig with zip-ties or quick links: Determine rigging points and move onto step 4.



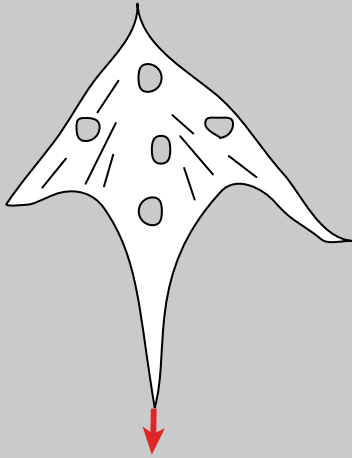
To rig with tie line: Determine rigging points and an approximate length for the line. Attach the lines to the loops using zip-ties.

4. Secure the first loop to one of the rigging points using the chosen rigging method.

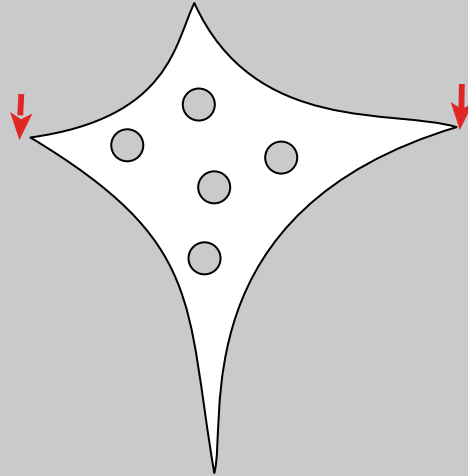


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5. Locate the loop opposite of the secured point and stretch away from it. Attach this before moving on to the other points. This establishes the correct tension.



6. Attach the remaining points. Tidy up any excess tie line if it was used.



Trouble Shooting:

- If wrinkles are present:
 - * Stretch farther to increase tension;
 - * Be sure opposite points are stretched along the same plane.
- If there are no rigging points for the bottom loops:
 - * Use sand bags with tie line to weigh these points down.

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
