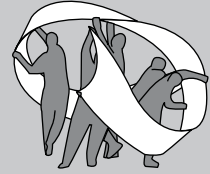

- 2 L-Joints

- 1 Roll Black Electrical Tape
- 5 Nude Leotard
- 5 Black Body Suit
- 5 Pair of Black Booties

- Site Plan/Event Layout
- Five Person Team Min.
- Plastic Drop Cloth
- Gloves

- Sewing Kit
- Dance Shoes
- Men: Dance Belt Recommended



Due to the uniqueness of the Ribbon performance, we highly recommend hiring a Pink installation supervisor.

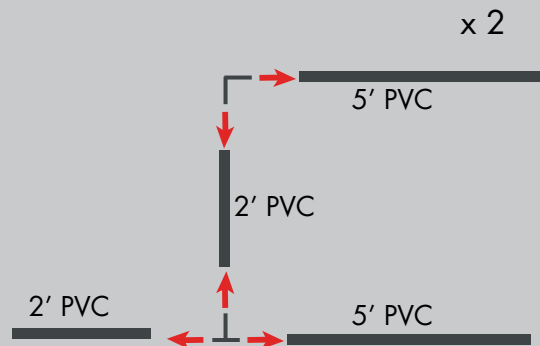

Be sure to have these pieces near the final location.

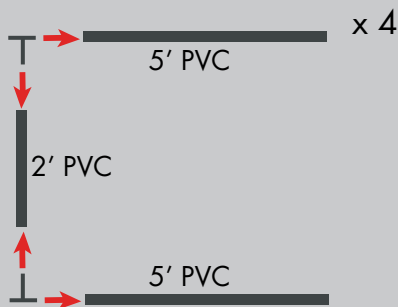
- 5' PVC x 12
- 2' PVC x 9
- T-Joints x 12
- L-Joints x 2

Prior to assembly, lay out drop cloth in designated work location. Before working with fabric, wash hands or put on gloves.

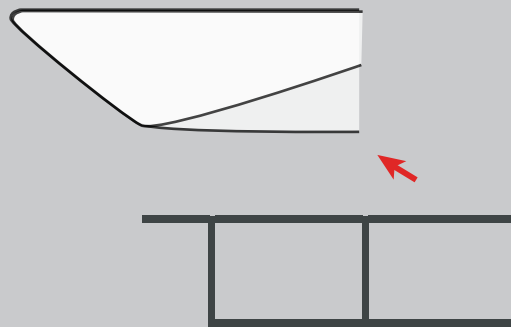
1. Begin by assembling sections of the Ribbon. Start with the following section:



2. Next, create 4 of the following sections. You will have one piece of 2' pipe and two T-Joints remaining.



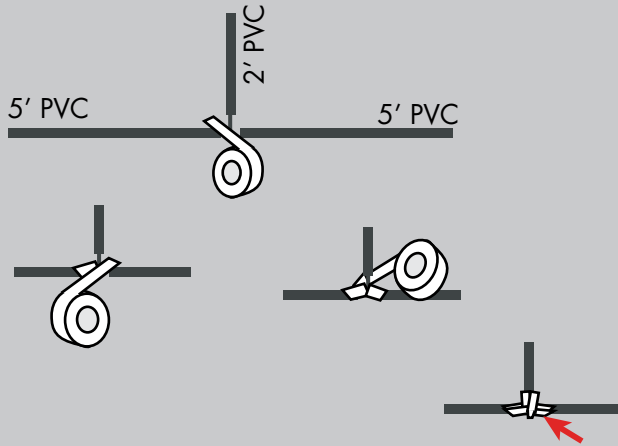
3. Unzip the fabric, attach the pieces, and set into place.



The Ribbon is 34' when laid flat. It will be easiest if everyone helps in this step. Taping joints will help keep them in place.

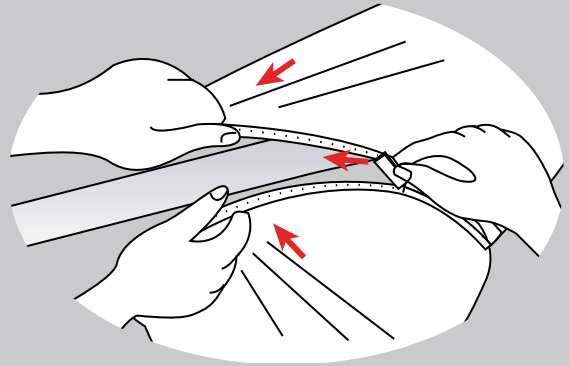
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4. Joint taping: Electrical tape works best.

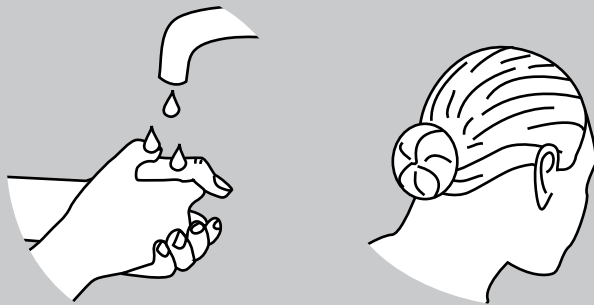


Wrap each joint two or three times. Make sure to leave a tab for easy removal afterwards.

5. Finish the Ribbon assembly by zipping the fabric closed. Have one person pull the fabric together while another one zips. The total length of the Ribbon is 34'.



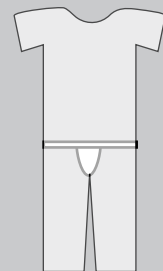
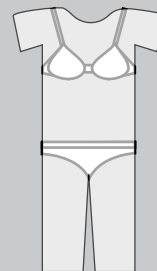
6. The performers now need to put on the costumes. Please wash hands before handling the costumes. If you have long hair, pull it back into a low bun as it tends to get warm in the costumes.



7. Locate the nude leotard and put on first.  
Women: place over regular undergarments.  
Men: place over recommended dance belt.

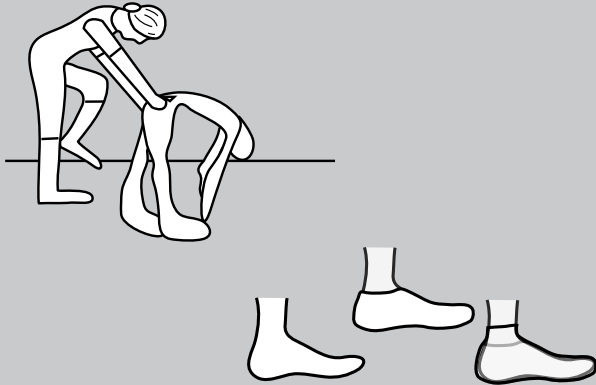

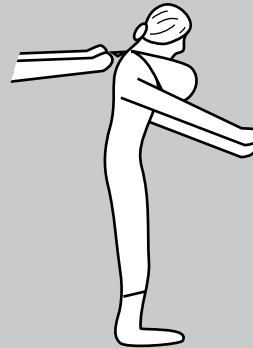
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8. Step into the body suit (the zipper should be in the back.) Before completely zipping the body suit, put on your dance shoes, followed by the provided booties.



Water moccasins are an acceptable dance shoe substitute.

9. Place arms and head into the suit and have someone else zip you up. You will have visibility through the fabric, but please be careful.



10. With all five performers dressed and the Ribbon assembled, the performance may begin. See the next page for inspiration.



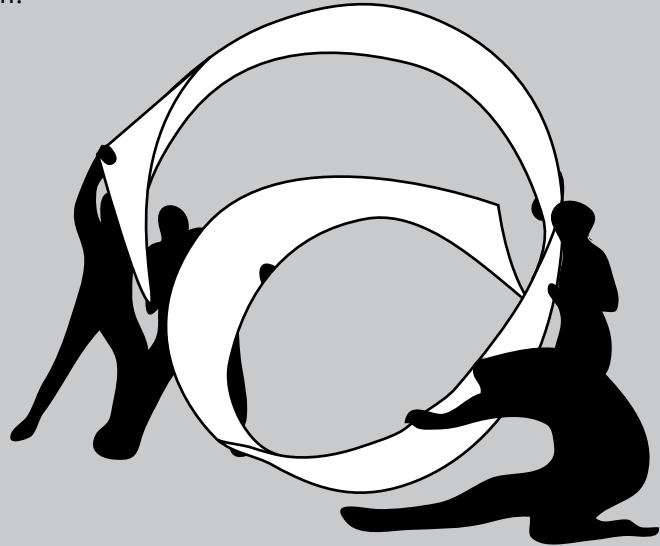
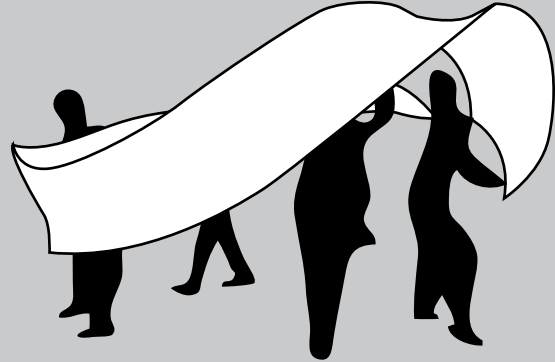
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11. Movement should be elegant, organic, and fluid. The Ribbon should travel in curved, flowing paths, and never in straight lines.

To manipulate, use the ends and middle to lift up and down. Have people move away from and towards each other at different levels. Avoid "everyday" poses and never stop moving.

Practice several motions, poses, and height variations before performing.
