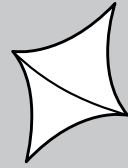

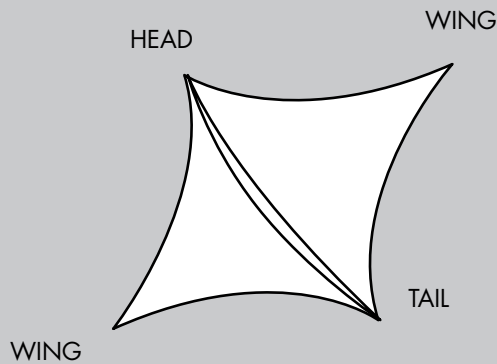

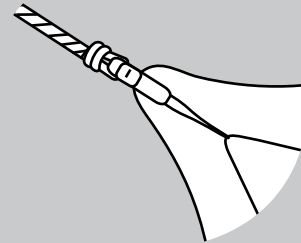

1. Remove Soaring Bird from bag and spread out between two people. Identify the following parts:

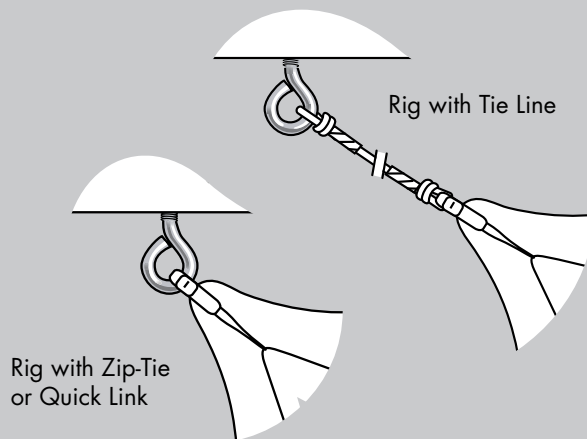


2. To rig with zip-ties or quick links:  
Determine rigging points and move onto step 3.

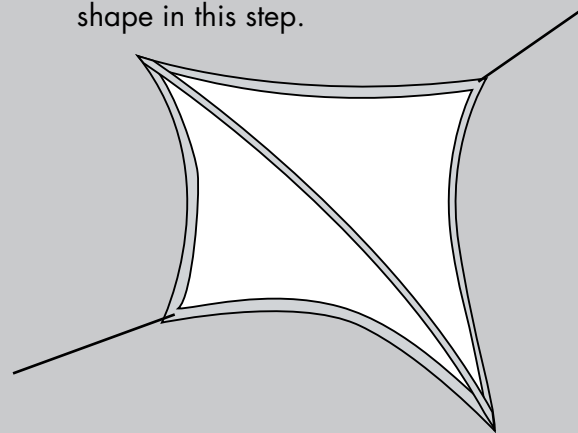
To rig with tie line:  
Determine rigging points and an approximate length for the line. Attach the lines to the loops using zip-ties. Having too much tie line is better than "just enough."



3. Secure the first loop (usually one of the wings) to one of the rigging points using the chosen rigging method.

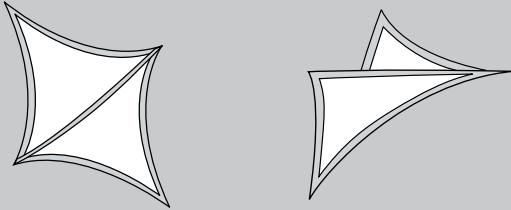


4. Locate the loop and point opposite of the secured point. Attach this before moving on to the other points. This establishes the correct tension. You will see the Bird take shape in this step.

5. Depending on the situation, you may choose to attach only one of the remaining points. If it needs tweaking, attach the last point for another work spot. Tidy up any excess tie line.



There are two common ways to rig the Bird: soaring and taking flight.

Trouble Shooting:

- If wrinkles are present:
  - \* Stretch further to increase tension;
  - \* Be sure opposite points are stretched along the same plane.
